Quick brings Stanley Cup to Greenwich

Los Angeles Kings star goalie Jonathan Quick recently brought the Stanley Cup to Greenwich.

Mike Anthony of The Hartford Courant reported that the former Milford and Hamden resident, who helped the Kings win the Stanley Cup, held a private party in Greenwich where approximately 200 guests had an opportunity to touch the Cup.

Quick, who was awarded the Conn Smythe Trophy as the playoff's MVP, held the celebration in Greenwich on July 27, the same day he conducted his Jon Quick all ages Goaltending Camp at Stamford Twin Rinks. Quick, who has held the clinic for three years, also displayed the Stanley Cup to the many children at the event.

An Avon Old Farms School graduate, the 26-year-old Quick is coming off a sensational 2012 season. An All-Star selection and Vezina Trophy runner-up, he registered 35 regular season victories and a franchise-record 10 shutouts for the Kings. He recently signed a 10-year contract extension worth \$58 million.

Quick's wife Jaclyn (Backman) is a 2005 Greenwich High School graduate. Greenwich High sports fans may remember that Jaclyn, known as Jackie to her teammates, was a standout field hockey player for the Cardinals. She's the daughter of former New York Rangers forward Mike Backman and the brother of Sean Backman, who plays for the Bridgeport Sound Tigers.
